Redesignated 19 February 1942 as 152d
Field Artillery Battalion, an element of
43d Division

Inactivated 14 October 1945 at Camp
Stoneman, Calif.

Redesignated 21 May 1946 as the 203d
Field Artillery Battalion and relieved
from assignment to 43d Infantry Division,
and consolidated 1 July 1946 with the
314th Antiaircraft Artillery Automatic
Weapons Battalion
